

# We Need to Hear from You about Living with a Neurological Condition



The Neurological Alliance of Ireland is the national umbrella group representing over thirty charities working with people with neurological conditions and their families. We have launched a survey to ask people about their experience of living with a neurological condition in Ireland.

## What is the survey about?

The survey asks people with neurological conditions and family carers about their experience of living with a neurological condition. We carried out a similar survey in 2014 and the findings of this survey will be compared to what we found out then, what has changed/stayed the same and what new challenges are facing people in 2018.

## Who can complete the survey?
