Patient Experience Survey of Outpatient Neurology Services



The Neurological Alliance of Ireland, the umbrella representing over 30 patient organisations, in partnership with the National Clinical Programme in Neurology, has launched the first ever patient experience survey of outpatient neurology services in Ireland.

What is the survey about?

The survey asks service users about their experience of outpatient neurology services. Neurology services are those delivered in a hospital by a Consultant Neurologist and members of their team. This survey ONLY asks people about their experience with neurology services, it does not deal with other aspects of care such as from your GP or other services in the community.

Why should I take part?

It is important to share your experience in order to help identify areas of the service that can be improved over time.

Who can complete the survey?

The survey can be completed by any person with a neurological condition who is currently attending a neurology outpatient service as a patient or has attended any time in the last five years.

There is also a separate survey available which can be completed by a family member on behalf of a person with a neurological condition. However, only one of you should complete the survey.

Where can I find the survey?

You can only complete the survey online.
